1. HOLY TRINITY CHURCH

a. Baptism Candidate

Sermon Title: The Morning That Changes Everything

Sermon Text: John 20:1-18

Preacher: Revd Adrian Chong

What are the life-changing moments you have experienced? Can you name any moments that change the course of history? Is there a life-changing moment for everyone on earth?

John 20:1-2

We are not sure if Mary went into the tomb, but she certainly did look. If not, she would not have said: "They have taken the Lord out." The Disciple that the Lord loved, as agreed by most scholars, is John.

1. Went back due to ignorance

John 20:3-10

Peter and John ran to the tomb as quickly as possible. John reached first but did not go in; Peter came later and dashed in. Whether they hesitated or rushed in, neither understood. John believed, but most probably believed what Mary said, and not the fact that Jesus had resurrected. The text clearly said: "as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that he must rise from the dead."

As a result of their ignorance, they went back to where they came from. The Gospel has never been proclaimed more in this era than ever before, through the bible, both printed and online, gospel rallies, the internet, and social media. Yet many chose to ignore, and their ignorance causes them to remain where they are. This event that changes the whole world missed them by and could not benefit them.

2. Not recognised by not letting go

John 20:11-15

Mary stayed on and wept; she could not understand when the angels spoke to her. In fact, she couldn't even recognise Jesus when he spoke. What has caused her "blindness"? Of the many reasons, it could be anxiety, worry, and other feelings in her heart that caused her to be unable to focus and miss out on Jesus.

Many of us could have heard the Good News or maybe even understood it. However, we let other pursuits and commitments in life cause us to miss out on it. Pursuits such as wealth, pleasure, lust, or even letting our emotions of hurt and anxiety have the better of us. This event that changes the whole world may be known to us, but we are still not able to benefit from it yet.

3. Preach forth in relationship

John 20:16-18

When Jesus finally called her “Mary.” That familiar call, or accent, caused her to spontaneously reply “rabboni.” Yes, that bond and relationship that they had sprung back to life, and the relationship was reconstructed. Because of that relationship, she is now able to become a spokesperson for Jesus. She is given the mission to bring the message back to his disciples.

Many of us have built this relationship with Jesus. Many more today through baptism. Are we ready to be the spokesperson for Jesus? Are we ready to build up this relationship by proclaiming His Good News?
