Key Message:

The new life in Christ is lived humbly, vigilantly, and confidently—between what Christ has done (the Cross) and what God has promised (the Crown).

Key Movements:

- 1. The Posture We Are Given**
Humility before God and toward one another
 - 2. The Warning We Must Hear**
Vigilance in a real spiritual battle
Secure—but never careless
 - 3. The Promises That Carry Us**
Grace, care, restoration, glory
 - 4. The God Who Finishes**
Our hope rests not in ourselves, but in God's faithful work

Humility in Action: Pray

Be Sober-Minded, Be Watchful (1 Peter 5:8)

- **Prayer for Clarity**
Lord, clear our minds from distraction, complacency, and spiritual dullness.
- **Prayer for Humble Alertness**
Keep us awake without making us anxious, watchful without becoming fearful.
- **Prayer for Discernment**
Help us recognise where the enemy seeks to deceive, divide, or quietly erode our faith.
- **Prayer for Dependence**
Teach us to watch and pray—never trusting our strength more than Your grace.
- **Prayer for the Community**
Guard our church to be vigilant together, shepherding one another in humility and love.
- **Prayer for Perseverance**
In seasons of weariness, anchor us in Your promises and strengthen us to stand firm.

Cell Group Discussion Questions

2. How does remembering that the flock belongs to God (not us) reshape the way we serve, lead, or relate to one another?
3. What promises of God do you find most strengthening when suffering or pressure feels ongoing—and how can the community help remind you of them?
