When God makes all things new, He doesn't just improve our lives—He takes over completely.

We are now living **under new management**.

1. The Announcement of New Management (Isaiah 65:17; Rev 21:1)

“See, I will create new heavens and a new earth...”

2. The Culture Change – From Sorrow to Joy (Isaiah 65:18–19; Rev 21:4)

Every organization reflects its leadership.

Under God's management, life is:

“Before they call I will answer...”

5. The Transformed Environment – Peace Replaces Conflict (Isaiah 65:25)
