1. Our Parish

2. Our World

2. For peace in war-torn places, that Christ's hope would shine through those who help.
3. For the persecuted church, that God would sustain them and secure their reward.

3. Our Nation, Singapore

1. For our government leaders, that they govern with justice and that we pray faithfully.
2. For open hearts in Singapore to the gospel, and boldness for us to show kindness.
3. For unity and graciousness in our multi-racial society, that our love witnesses well.

4. The Sick, Vulnerable, and Weary

1. For the sick, elderly, grieving and needy, that we see and refresh them as we would Christ.
2. For caregivers and families, that God strengthens them and renews their hope.

INTRODUCTION

Matthew 10 – the Missionary Discourse

- ⁴⁰ “Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives Him who sent me.
Receive = δέχομαι (*dechomai*): an intentional & deliberate, hospitable embrace.
- The missionary discourse is about embracing the Kingdom of God.
- Biblical Discipleship (Matt 28:19-20)

THE CHALLENGES OF THE MODERN CHURCH REGARDING BIBLICAL DISCIPLESHIP:

#1 The Mandate Misunderstood (Matt 28:19-20)

- observe: *tēreō* = signifies a conscious and intentional commitment to follow and apply Christ’s teachings in one’s life.
- The parable of the wise and foolish builder (Matt 7:24-27)
- Illustration of a couch potato trying to lose weight: “But unless you put into practice everything you learn, you are merely informed but not transformed.”

#2 The Practical Shift from the Mandate

- The preference for isolation.
- The rejection of hard sayings.
- The fear of accountability.
- The dichotomy between Sunday and Monday.
- The curse of busyness.
- The encroachment of the digital world.
- The focus on self rather than transformation.

A LESSON FROM THE EARLY CHURCH ON BIBLICAL DISCIPLESHIP:

#3 THE SPIRIT-EMPOWERED TRANSFORMATIONAL GROWTH:

- Acts 2:42-47 “They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching...”
 - They practice what they learned.
 - Biblical Discipleship takes place in a community.

THE GENERATIONAL EFFECT OF BIBLICAL DISCIPLESHIP:

#4 THE MANDATE PASSED-ON:

- 2 Tim 2:2
 - Paul, Timothy, Faithful Men, Others (4 generations)
 - Jesus didn’t intent for discipleship to begin and end with us.

CONCLUSION:

- Biblical Discipleship is not an option, but the mandate of Jesus Christ.

Share: Who is the one person who has a positive influence over your spiritual growth? How has he influenced you, and in what ways has it changed your personality?

1. Read Matthew 28:19-20 & Matthew 7:24-27. From the texts, share what is currently missing in your own journey of faith or growth towards spiritual maturity.
2. Of the seven practical shift from the mandate of Biblical Discipleship. Identify the areas that you are struggling with. Share how as a small group, you can help one another to overcome some of these areas.
 - The preference for isolation.
 - The rejection of hard sayings.
 - The fear of accountability.
 - The lack of training for the mundane.
 - The curse of busyness.
 - The encroachment of the digital world.
 - The focus on care and not transformation.
3. Read 2 Timothy 2:2. Think of the person who has positively influenced your spiritual life. Share how you would like to pass it on in the coming days.
