Prayer Pointers

Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for Him. (Psalm 37:7a)

1. Our Parish

a. NET Ministry

Pray for a smooth leadership transition from Owen Lum to Jaden Chan. Ask for God's wisdom and discernment upon the Youth advisers: Gabriel, Lynn, Rachel, Jared, Stephanie, and youth leaders: Gideon, Audrey, Jaden as they lead the youths. Pray that the youths will grow in a deeper knowledge of God's love and become a community that loves God and loves others.

b. Diocese of Singapore

Ask our all-powerful God to grant Bishop Titus Chung, the Diocesan office, and the Clergy Team a supernatural renewal of strength and spiritual refreshment. Pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit to give them a fresh vision, revive hearts, and graciously reaffirm His sacred calling on their lives to shepherd His flock with power and wisdom.

2. The World

a. Pray for the Middle East situation

Ask our all-powerful God to intervene in the escalating conflict and naval blockades. Pray for His mercy to shield innocent families, His grace to stop the violence, and His wisdom to guide leaders toward peace.

b. Pray for Sudan and the DRC

Cry out for the Lord's healing power over millions facing starvation in Sudan and the Ebola outbreak in the Congo. Pray for God's mercy to comfort the displaced and protect vulnerable children.

3. Our Nation – Singapore

a. Pray for Resilience Amid Global Economic Storms:

Let us ask our all-powerful God to protect Singapore as it navigates a prolonged storm of global political instability and inflation risks. Pray for His sovereign grace to shield local families from the rising costs of living, and for His mercy to grant divine wisdom to our government leaders as they manage national economic policies.

b. Pray for the deep spiritual awakening and moral resilience of our people:

Pray that local churches will remain unified, vibrant, and filled with the Holy Spirit—serving as pillars of truth and active beacons of Christ's love, hope, and peace to every corner of society.

4. The Sick, Vulnerable, and Weary and the Caregivers

Pray for God's healing, comfort, and peace for the sick, vulnerable, and weary, and for renewed strength through the Holy Spirit.

Pray for caregivers, both medical and family, for patience, resilience, sufficient resources, and God's sustaining joy and love.

Remember that the world belongs to God

- There is a misconception that the world belongs to those in power, but the parable tells us that the world belongs to Christ.
- Do we feel that we are slaves to the world or stewards of God?

Remember not to destroy the good with the evil

- The parable warns us not to be too hasty in destroying evil, but to let good grow alongside evil, so we don't mistakenly destroy good with evil. This is to ensure good has enough time to grow, leading to a full harvest
- What difficulty might you have in being patient in the midst of growing evil?

Remember that you are a son of the kingdom

- When interpreting the parable Jesus' focus shifts to the identity of the wheat and the righteous that will "shine like the sun."
- Right framing of our identity leads to right action
- How can remembering our identity affirmed by Christ give you hope?
