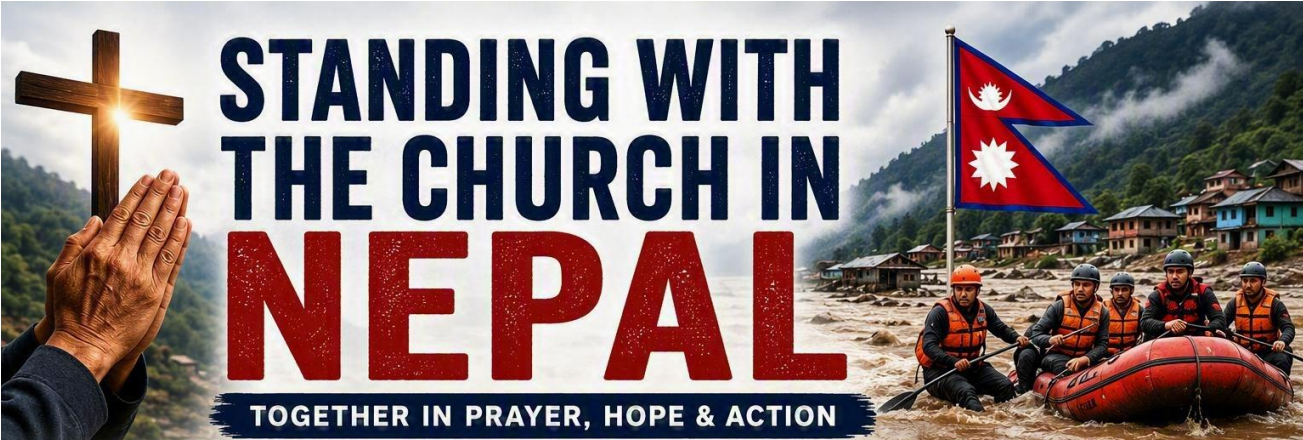

Prayer Pointers

“For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,” declares the LORD. “As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.” (Isaiah 55:8-9)

1. Our Parish

- **Children Ministry**

Pray for our Children’s Ministry to be a place where children grow in the knowledge and love of Jesus Christ, where teachers and volunteers are filled with wisdom, patience, joy, and strength, and where every child is protected, nurtured, and led to genuine faith (Proverbs 22:6; Mark 10:14). Pray also for parents and families, that the Lord would help them to partner well in raising children who love God, and that our ministry would bear lasting fruit for His glory.

- **Mid-Autumn Carnival:**

Thank God for the helpers who have signed up, and pray for smooth-running programmes, favourable weather, and eager hearts among members to invite family, friends, and neighbours, that the event would be a joyful witness and a gateway for the gospel; “let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven” (Matthew 5:16).

2. The World

- **Global and Asia**

Pray for those affected by the Nepal floods, especially grieving families, the missing, and the displaced, and for people in Sudan, Ukraine, and Gaza who continue to face war, hunger, and loss; ask the Lord, who is “our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble” (Psalm 46:1), to bring comfort to the broken-hearted, protection for the vulnerable, and swift, effective humanitarian aid to all who are suffering.

- **ASEAN**

Pray for the people in Myanmar and other parts of Southeast Asia who are facing conflict and flooding, for the displaced, and for the rescue and relief workers labouring in difficult conditions; ask the Lord to grant wise leadership and pray that local churches would be places of refuge, compassion, and hope.

3. Our Nation – Singapore

- Pray for vulnerable groups affected by the haze and heat, especially the elderly, children, and those with chronic illness, and for wisdom and strength for agencies, churches, and volunteers supporting them.
- Pray for Singapore churches to be united in prayer, renewed in spiritual hunger, and bold in serving the nation and proclaiming Christ, remembering that “if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face... then I will hear from heaven” (2 Chronicles 7:14).

3. The Sick, Vulnerable, and Weary and the Caregivers

- Pray for God’s healing, peace, and Holy Spirit renewal for the sick, vulnerable, and weary; and for patience, resilience, sufficient resources, and sustaining joy for all medical and family caregivers.
