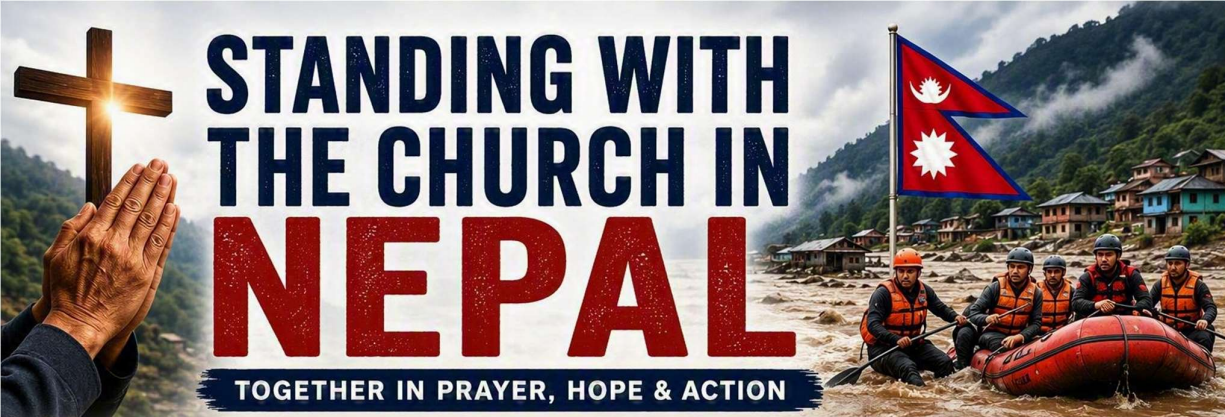

1. Our Parish

Mid-Autumn Carnival (19 Sept 2026)

- Give thanks for the many neighbours, families, and friends who joined us at the carnival, and for the warm fellowship shared between church members and the community.
- Ask God to nurture the new friendships formed, and to open fresh opportunities for Gospel conversations, that many may come to know Christ through the relationships begun at the carnival.

Institution & Induction of Rev Adrian Chong Kum Cheong (1 Nov 2026)

- Ask that, as promised in *Isaiah 50:4*, God will give him "the word that sustains the weary", enabling him to speak truth with grace, bring hope to the discouraged, and point many to Christ.
- Pray that he will hear the Lord's voice afresh each day, discern God's direction for Holy Trinity Church, and lead the parish with humility, conviction, and spiritual authority.

Those Who Serve Behind the Scenes

- Give thanks for the many faithful members who serve quietly in administration, hospitality, worship support, communications, maintenance, logistics, and other unseen ministries.
- Ask God to refresh them with renewed joy and strength as they continue partnering in the new things He is doing in our parish and community.

2. The World

- Pray for people displaced by conflicts and humanitarian crises around the world. Ask God to make a way where there seems to be no way, providing protection, provision, and hope for refugees and vulnerable families, and raising peacemakers who will work towards reconciliation and lasting peace.

3. Our Nation – Singapore

- Pray for families in Singapore facing the pressures of rising living costs, work demands, caregiving responsibilities, and mental well-being challenges. Ask God to bring fresh hope, strengthen family relationships, and provide new pathways of support through communities, churches, and caring relationships.

4. The Sick, Vulnerable, Weary, and Caregivers

- Pray for those experiencing mental and emotional exhaustion, that the Lord will renew their strength, bring streams of hope into weary hearts, and help them perceive His presence and faithfulness even in difficult seasons.

Growth has a deadline because harvest has a date.

1. GROWTH HAS A CONTEXT

Whose mark do you bear? (*Revelation 14:1*)

We are shaped by who we belong to, who we worship, and who we reflect.

2. GROWTH HAS A PURPOSE

God grows us to become like Christ. (*Revelation 14:1-5*)

Marked by the Father, following the Lamb, and reflecting His character.

3. GROWTH HAS A DEADLINE

The harvest is coming. (*Revelation 14:6-15*)

No one stays neutral. The season of growth will not remain open forever.
