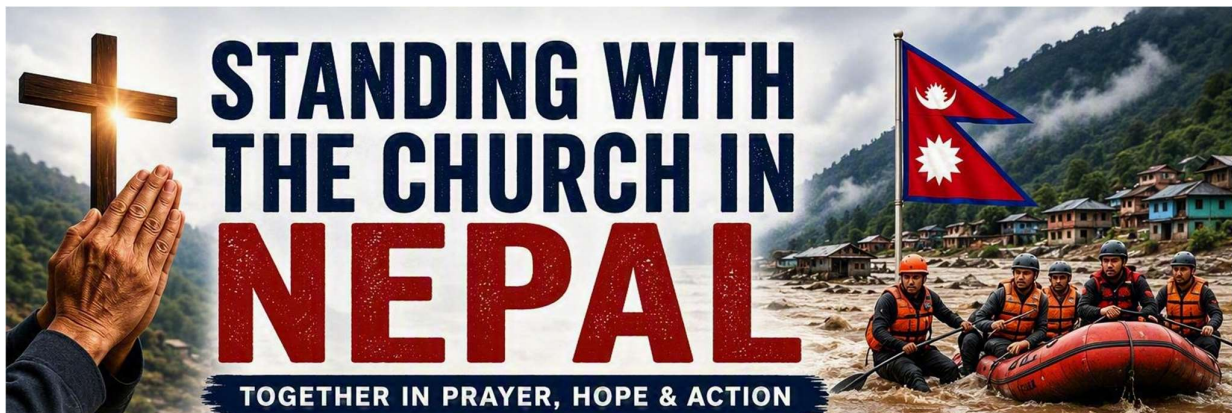

Prayer Pointers

1. Our Parish

- Pray for provision and relief for those facing famine in Somalia, Sudan, and among displaced Rohingya communities, and for those affected by natural disasters across Asia. Pray for protection and strength for affected families, and wisdom for governments and relief agencies responding to these crises.

- Pray for Singapore's government and public service leaders, that God would grant them wisdom, integrity and discernment as they make decisions and carry out their responsibilities for the good of the nation and its people.
