## **Session 2: With Radiance**

**Overview:** Last Sunday, Dave preached from With Authority. This week, He focused in on With Radiance - Jesus is the Radiance of God's Glory, and proximity to Him should steadily transform us into His likeness, because we cannot radiate someone we do not spend time with. The call to refuse "good without God" examines who we are becoming and radiating, and living out the Christian faith with integrity before Jesus both publicly and privately. When we fix our gaze on Jesus and spend time with Jesus, we become more and more like Him and that radiates in our lives, shaping our lives for heaven, not just here on earth.

- 4. Have you ever felt the pressure to change who you are depending who you are around? What does faithfulness over visibility look like in that area for you?
