

# Session 2: Medics In A Dying World

## Overview:

This Sunday, we continued in the series Ecclesia. The message teaches us that the church (Ecclesia) is not just a Sunday gathering but a people sent with authority to bring the Kingdom of God into everyday life, Monday through Saturday. Like medics in a dying world, believers are equipped by the church to move toward brokenness, to love their neighbors, and push back against darkness wherever God has already placed them. ## Discussion Questions:

1. You can't love God and hate His mission - What do you think God's mission looks like in your current season of life?
2. In the parable of the Good Samaritan, why do you think the priest and Levite passed by the wounded man? What are some modern day reasons we may do the same?
3. The church was compared to medics in a dying world, what stands out to you about this image and how will it encourage and shape you going forward approaching people who are hurting or far from God?
4. Who has God already placed in your everyday rhythms (work, family, neighborhood, school) that you may be overlooking as part of your mission field?
5. Pastor Caleb encouraged us to Pray, Pay attention, and Follow up with people in our everyday lives. How can you start taking steps in this today?

**Prayer:** Lord, thank you for not passing us by when we were hurt and wounded, forgive us for moments that we have treated church as a place to attend rather than a mission to live, open our eyes to those currently hurting and wounded around us and help us to carry your hope, compassion love and truth to those hurting.
