

Session 3: Why We Gather

Overview: As we continued our series in Ecclesia Pastor Mike preached to Why we gather. The Ecclesia - citizens of heaven gather to worship, surrender fully to God, and be formed as a spiritual family, because the environments we commit to will shape who we become, so we must spend time in environments that the presence of God will be in. When we worship with both our hearts and the Word, God uses His presence to expose sin, break chains, and call us higher into holiness, reminding us that crisis reveals who truly reigns in our lives. As we consistently put God's word to work, refusing to be soft to sin because sin won't be soft with us and choosing steady faithfulness, we grow stronger and more transformed. Low and slow so we can truly grow.
