

Session 2: Building A Home Of Great Faith

Overview:

This week we continued our talk - Home Team. Pastor Dave touched on how important it is for our homes to be built on the foundation of Jesus and Faith. Whether we are biological parents or spiritual mothers and fathers our homes matter and what we say and do in our homes matters. Whether single, married or with children now is the time to get rooted and planted in church. Culture says control the environment our children are in, and although we cannot control all the environments our children are in we can disciple them that when they face challenges and temptation they would be able to turn from temptation and walk in the truth of 1 John 4:4. We are called higher to be the example because children rarely learn by what we say, but by what we do.

Discussion Questions:

1. Pastor Dave talks about how leadership starts at home, particularly when no one sees. What does leading yourself closer to Jesus in your home look like right now? How can you improve?
2. 1 John 4:4 says "Greater is He that is in you, then He that is in the world" How can we practically help the people in our homes believe and live out this truth when facing temptation of the pressures of culture?
3. This sermon emphasized how children often imitate more of what they see rather than what they're told. What are some ways our actions might be shaping ourselves and others positively or negatively within our homes?
4. What is one practical change you feel led to make this week to help your home be built more on faith and become more rooted in Jesus?
