

Session 3: The Home Where Jesus Is

Overview: This week we leaned back into our talk Home Team, where Pastor Dave focused on “The Home Where Jesus Is.” As followers of Jesus, our homes should look different from the world’s standards. Change begins within our own homes, so church becomes an extension of our home, not an escape from it. A home where Jesus is present is one where He is worshipped, celebrated, and talked about. It’s marked by surrendered pride, brokenness being healed and being quick to forgive, both inside and outside the home. When we center our homes on Jesus and prioritize time with Him, we get more of Him and forgiveness then begins to speak louder than brokenness.
