

Session 4: Man School / Woman School

Overview: This Sunday we continued our talks with the Home Team. Pastor Dave talked with us of how we are not just raising kids but we're intentionally raising future men and women of God, building our homes with a backbone of daily rhythms (wake, meal and bedtimes) arms of intentional discipleship like man school, woman school and shared experiences, and a head that keeps everything aligned and focused - this head being Jesus. None of these work without Jesus - He must be the captain of our home team, the one who leads, shapes, and empowers our families to become who He's called each of us to be.

Discussion Questions:

1. When you hear the phrase "we're not just raising kids, but future men and women of God" what does that stir in you?
2. In **Ephesians 6:4** fathers are told not to exasperate their children but to train them in the Lord - what are ways parents can correct without discouraging?
3. Pastor Dave touched on the backbone of wake times, meal time and bedtimes. Which of those rhythms feels strongest in your home? Which one feels hardest to establish?
4. Camping and shared experiences were highlighted as catalysts for connection - what are some shared experiences you have built and created that have brought stronger connection into the home? What are some experiences you could begin to incorporate?

ACTION STEP: Participate in One Day To Feed The World
