

## Session 2: The Journey Of Heaven

**Overview:** This Sunday we continued in our collection of talks titled “Heaven as Home. Pastor Dave reminded us that the journey to eternity is real and shaped by our response to Jesus, that our citizenship is a choice based on a price He already paid. Scripture shows us two eternal destinations, not three. Heaven with Christ or separation from Him and that death is not the end, but the doorway to eternal reality. For those following Jesus, the central joy for us is being at home with the resurrected Jesus, our blessed hope where we will one day see Him face to face. Pastor Dave spoke on Luke 16:19-31 and how we should not wait to see something supernatural or extraordinary to believe in Jesus, but to believe in Him now.
