

## Session 3: Hebrews Vol. 3

**Overview:** This Sunday we continued in our collection of talks titled “Hebrews”. Over the past couple weeks we have been going over tools to help us study and interpret the Bible even when reading on our own. This Sunday Pastor Caleb leaned into the importance of context when reading scripture, and that when we read the Bible without context, not knowing the true context we could come up with our own interpretations leading to potentially being misled or let down. The Word of God is a sword, but when we do not use a sword properly how it's supposed to be, we could hurt ourselves or even others. Pastor Caleb also spoke of Hebrews 6 and the importance of growing in our faith, becoming spiritually productive and mature.

3. The people in Hebrews wanted Jesus as Savior, but not Lord. Why do you think full surrender and obedience can be difficult even for believers today?
4. Looking honestly at your own life, where do you feel God calling you to grow deeper in your faith, consistency or understanding of scripture?
