

Session 4: Hebrews Vol. 4

Overview: This Sunday we continued in our collection of talks titled “Hebrews”. Over the past few weeks we’ve gone over tools to help us better understand the Bible which include, not putting our opinions into the Bible but pulling the truth out, knowing the original author and audience that it was written to, the power of prayer and asking the Holy Spirit to help us understand and change our perspective, the importance of context, and this Sunday Pastor Dave spoke to associations as we reflected on Jesus being our eternal High Priest and challenged us to examine ourselves to what or who we may be placing above Jesus, reminding us that Jesus is better than everyone and everything, and how God does not promise to change our circumstances but that He can change our perspective on how we view things.

Discussion Questions:

1. Have there been seasons where God has changed your perspective more than your circumstances? What did that teach you?
2. What are some things we as people commonly place above Jesus in our lives without even realizing?
3. Pastor Dave said ‘Faith has no middle ground, you’re either moving closer to Jesus or drifting’. In what ways do you feel yourself moving closer to Jesus, or drifting away?
4. What is something or someone you have placed above Jesus?

Prayer: Heavenly Father, thank you for the truth of your word, help us to better understand it and that we would become doers of the Word, reveal to us anything or anyone that we have placed above you Jesus, and give us a fresh perspective to our circumstances, in Jesus name, Amen.
