Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to inform you of our after-school program beginning **August 4th**. We will be hosting the following:

Monday-Thursday - Title I Afterschool Academic Program from 2:30 pm – 3:30 pm

Fridays-Hybrid Day - If enrolled in the Boys & Girls Club Afterschool Program, students will be supervised from 11:15 am to 3:00 pm (SGA will transport students to Club) & if enrolled in the K-1 Gator Care Program, students will be supervised from 11:15 am to 4:30 pm.

Students need to be picked up from Southgate Academy at the conclusion of Title I afterschool program or alternative afterschool arrangements need to be made.

For students who need extended care, Southgate will be providing Gator Care for students **ages 5-6 on-site (Southgate) from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm Mon.- Thurs. and from 11:15 pm to 4:30 pm on Fridays.**

Students **ages 7-17 will be provided an opportunity to register for the Boys and Girls Club – Roy Drachman Clubhouse at no cost to our parents.** Southgate will be paying for the tuition and providing registered students transportation to the Boys and Girls Club following the Title I afterschool program. Parents are responsible for picking up their student(s) at the Boys and Girls Club facility. Detailed information regarding the program offered by the Boys and Girls Club and registration instructions are attached.

If you wish for Southgate to transport your student(s) to the Boys and Girls Club, please sign and return the attached authorization form.

Clubhouse History

The modular buildings from Steve Daru were placed in Mission Park, refurbished and opened on November 3, 1992 as a third site of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Tucson. The clubhouse was named for Roy Drachman who was an honorary chairman of the capital drive in 1986 and a major contributor to the Boys & Girls Club. Frank X. Morton provided the first year operating funds for this new clubhouse. Lofthrop and the Tucson Conquistadores provided the funding to construct the Gymnasium in 1994. In 1995 the permanent Activity Center was built through strong support from the City, County and our donors. The new facility was opened for use in 1996.
