


Refer to the next page for instructions on how to fold your Cootie Catcher

3. Pick a different number, open the flap to read the joke!




Cut out the square









I SPY WINTER!

Can you find everything you would need for a cozy winter?




- A Hat that covers your ears

- An ice cream for a sweet treat





Get Saleh the Snowman ready for Salah!





SNOWFLAKE SLIME

Make your own snowflake slime, ask your parents for permission first.

You'll need:

1 tablespoon Saline Solution

(Ask a grown-up to check if the ingredients include sodium borate and boric acid)

1/2 cup Clear or White Washable PVA School Glue

1/2 cup water

1/2 teaspoon baking soda

Snowflake Confetti

Blue and silver glitter

Food colouring

Mixing bowl and spoon

Measuring cups and measuring spoons

Storage container

Instructions

1. Mix the glue and water.
2. Add in the baking soda.
3. Mix in the confetti, glitter and food colouring.
4. Mix in the saline solution.
5. Knead until it's SLIMY!
