- **Response** activities that address the short-term, direct effects of an incident and include immediate actions to save lives, protect property, and meet basic human needs
- Recovery long term activities that work towards restoring the community to pre-disaster norms or better

- Definition
 - 501(c)(3) organizations with a disaster response program and policy for commitment of resources (i.e., personnel, funds, equipment) to meet the needs of people anywhere in Davidson County affected by disaster without discrimination as to race, creed, gender or age.
- Expectations
 - Keep paperwork and contact information up to date.
 - Attend general VOAD meetings on a regular basis.
 - o Participate in committee work and annual training exercise.
 - Utilize Charity Tracker to coordinate services to survivors in disaster. *
- Benefits
 - o Voting rights (1 per organization)
 - o Logo on Nashville VOAD website
 - o Access to Charity Tracker client database to coordinate services in disaster. *
 - Invitations to general meetings, access to meeting notes, and inclusion on the email distribution list

Affiliate Member

- Definition
 - O Any organization within Davidson County with disaster planning and operations responsibilities or capabilities (including nonprofits without 501(c)(3) exemption) but do not meet the requirements for full membership and/or do not have the capacity to be engaged on a regular basis.
- Expectations
 - Keep paperwork and contact information up to date.
 - o Participation in annual training exercise.
 - o Attend meetings and participate in committees as time and resources allow.
 - Utilize Charity Tracker to coordinate services to survivors in disaster. *
- Benefits
 - o Logo on Nashville VOAD website
 - Access to Charity Tracker client database to coordinate services in disaster*
 - Invitations to general meetings, access to meeting notes, and inclusion on the email distribution list

- Definition
 - Any business, government agency, or institution within Davidson County with a willingness to engage and support the VOAD's preparedness and response activities.
- Expectations

 - Lend expertise to committees or meetings
 - Financial support
 - Attend trainings
 - Provide resources in disaster
 - Keep paperwork and contact information up to date.
