



## 2026 Teacher Appreciation Week Classroom Supply Program

### Eligibility and Program Rules

#### Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for the program, participants must:

- Be a **current K–12 teacher**
  - Work at a **U.S. public school**
  - Teach at a school where **at least 50% of students qualify for free or reduced-price lunch**
  - Continue meeting all eligibility criteria **through the time of award fulfillment** (or risk losing the award)
- 

#### Program Rules & Conditions

##### 1. Application Window & Cap

- Applications will be accepted from **April 19 through May 10**
- The program will accept a maximum of **5,000 applications**
- Once the **5,000 application limit is reached**, submissions may close early

##### 2. Award Details

- Teachers receive **classroom supplies valued up to \$500**
- Supplies are provided as a **pre-selected kit**
- **No cash or monetary grants** are given

##### 3. Use of Supplies

- Supplies must be used **only for educational purposes**
- Must **directly benefit students in the teacher's classroom**
- Supplies **cannot be:**
  - Resold



- Exchanged for cash
- Used for personal purposes

#### **4. Communications & Participation**

- Teachers may be invited to share:
  - Testimonials
  - Stories
  - Photos (**no children allowed in photos**)
- Participation in promotions or media is **completely optional**

#### **5. Media & Content Use**

- If materials are submitted, the Foundation may use them for:
  - Promotional
  - Educational
  - Communication purposes
- Teachers must ensure they have **permission from anyone featured**

#### **6. Publicity**

- The Foundation may publicly recognize:
  - The teacher
  - Their school
- Teachers **cannot use Foundation branding** without prior approval

#### **7. Liability**

- The Foundation is **not responsible** for any issues resulting from use of the supplies

#### **8. Program Changes**

- The Foundation may **modify, suspend, or cancel** the program at any time

#### **9. Legal**

- Governed by the **laws of the State of Florida**
