## Registration Information

Registration will open for the 2026 summer soccer season on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026 with Sarnia Girls' Soccer Club (SGSC) and will remain open into the start of the season.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION & FACILITY RULES

- Per **Canada Soccer**, all players **MUST** wear shin guards during play and **NO jewelry** during Club play (except medical alert bracelets).
- Players are not permitted to play with a cast. (ie. broken wrist or arm), per Ontario & Canada Soccer.
- Players will be asked to sit off if these rules are not observed.
- Spectators may not sit on the same side of the fields as the team benches.
- Spectators must sit behind the fences at the front-most 2 fields.
- No special team requests or “buddy requests” for players to be matched together upon registration.
- Please be mindful that our parking lot is a busy place on game nights, and that we share the lot with Bluewater Gymnastics.
- Public washrooms are accessible to all during programming at the back of the Club building, NOT inside. Please help keep our washrooms clean. (Port-a-johns are available at mini fields & back fields).
- Please no bicycles, or dogs/pets on our soccer fields/grounds (with the exception of service animals).
- Alcohol, vaping and smoking are strictly prohibited on the premises.
