THE LODGING

Amy Slate's famous Amoray Dive Resort, located right on the bay in Key Largo offers luxurious rooms and one-bedroom villas. Each room is unique, and most are fully equipped with kitchens and screened porches, air conditioning, ceiling fans, and wifi. Guests enjoy the seclusion of a Caribbean plantation, yet are close to Key Largo's colorful artisan centers, waterfront restaurants, tiki bars, plus a pool and a sandy beach!

THE DIVING

Just a few short steps from your room you'll find the Amoray Diver, a 48ft spacious catamaran dive boat, which will whisk us out in comfort to the waters of the Key Largo where our hand-picked dive sites await.

Key Largo Marine Sanctuary and John Pennekamp Coral Reef Park are marine sanctuaries dedicated to protection and preservation of sea life, and the prohibition of hunting makes the critters less shy and more apt to explore right along side of you.

Filled with enchanting schools of fish, soft sponges, and vibrantly colored corals, the depths over the coral reef vary from 10 to 45 feet. Water temperatures range from 75 to 85 degrees depending on the season, and visibility is generally 100 feet or more. Our exclusive itinerary includes visits to some of the spectacular wrecks such as the Duane, Spiegel Grove, Benwood and Eagle.

Open Water students enjoy their first dives at Jules Undersea Lodge, site of America's only underwater hotel. With our skills perfected and comfort levels high, we'll head out to the reefs in the afternoon. Previously certified divers begin their trip on the reef, or are welcome to join us for a in-depth refresher at the lagoon.
