What is Cashless Hospital Admission and Discharge?

Cashless Hospital Admission and Discharge is an optional coverage under Biz PA. It offers a cashless admission facility at our panel hospitals in Malaysia for insured employees hospitalized due to an accident.

Know Your Coverage

This policy covers:

Cashless Hospital Admission and Discharge (for Accidental Medical Expenses Benefit) - Maximum RM2,000 for Cashless Facility

Notes:

- This cashless benefit will only be activated after 7 working days from the submission and acceptance of your proposal at our registered office.
- Food and drink poisoning is excluded from cashless admission.

This policy excludes:

- Insanity, committing or attempting to commit suicide (whether sane or insane), intentional self -inflicted injuries or any attempt threat.
- Any form of sickness, illness, disease, infection or parasites and/or Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) or AIDS Related Complex (ARC) or Human Immunodeficiency Virus Infection (HIV).
- Congenital defect, pre-existing physical or mental defect or infirmity.
- Provoked murder or assault, wilful exposure to needless peril except in an attempt to save human life.

The duration of coverage is 12 months. You need to renew your policy annually.

- Cooling Period: You may cancel your policy by returning the policy within 15 days from the date of delivery of the policy. You are entitled to the return of the full premium paid less deduction of any claims or expenses incurred by us in the issuance of the policy, provided no claims have been made.
- **Person Eligible:** The insured person must be between 16 to 70 years old, with the policy renewable up to age 75. All Malaysians, Malaysian permanent residents, work permit holders and pass holders legally residing in Malaysia.
- **Premium Warranty:** Premium must be paid and received by us within 60 days from the inception date of the cover, otherwise the cover is automatically cancelled, and you will still be responsible to pay the proportion of premium for the period We have been on risk.
