
As the draw is distributed, you will be allocated a "Field" that will be indicated with a letter (A-G). Note that this will be different each week, and all games are on field 5.

Role of the Coach(es) for training:

Your training sessions are coordinated internally and run by both coaches and/or other parent volunteers. We have a significant amount of resources available on the website to help with ideas, as well as the coaching courses run by the club.

They are not training for the Olympics at this age, we are just looking for fun, engaging skill development sessions.



Coaches Training

- **All** coaches and managers **must** have a valid and current working with children check. This is free for volunteers.
- We will be running free grassroots coaching clinics for all club coaches to attend.
- Minis specific Coaching Clinic night - **Compulsory U5, highly recommended U6 – Dates TBC**
- This will be run by Alex Tobin and will help you all understand some basic elements in running a training session. He will also be present at most training nights, offering advice and help.

Minis Game Format



- Your team of 10-12 all train together weekly, and gets split in half every week to play games on Saturdays (i.e. Sharks A and Sharks B).
- This split needs to be random and different each week. Not graded.

Minis Game Format



- The coaches take one team each (Sharks A or Sharks B) to their allocated playing field where they referee the game (which is why we need all volunteers to have a valid WWCC)
- It is their responsibility to ensure that all players from the team are on the field ready to go & that fair play is executed.
- There will always be two coaches on the pitch at a time, one from each playing team.



Minis Game Format

General

- Using a size 3 ball, the teams will play a 4 V 4 game against another team in their age group (max 4 on the field per team – non negotiable)
- There are no goalkeepers.
- The halves are 15 min in length with a 5 minute half time.
- Substitutions can happen at any time and are encouraged to occur frequently.
- No results or tables (non-competitive).



Minis Game Rules

- 5 metres from ball for all restarts
- No corners. Opposing team to pass from goal line.
- No throw ins from side lines. Opposing team to pass from sideline.
- Equal game time for all players is Kellyville's policy

Each team must nominate one person to come down to collect their gear during the available times. This does **not** need to be the coach/manager, a parent is fine but each team needs to make an effort to send someone down. Whoever attends will sign out the gear and are responsible for keeping it safe for the season.

Equipment Collection



- **Playing Gear:**

- 10 playing jerseys (Keep as a set > **NO ONE TAKES THEIR OWN JERSEY HOME**). Create a roster for collecting each week, washing together and bringing to the next game).





Kellyville Kolts Player Retention Analysis (2022–2026)




Period	Players Previous Year	Retained Next Year	Retention Rate
2022 → 2023	1,830	1,189	64.97%
2023 → 2024	2,004	1,356	67.66%
2024 → 2025	2,159	1,357	62.85%
2025 → 2026	2,134	1,428	66.92%



If annual retention is 66%, but 10–12% return later, then the multi-year retention rate is closer to 75–78%.




When would you contact the Welfare Officer?

- ✓ Safeguarding concerns (If a coach suspects a player might be at risk of harm e.g. abuse, neglect, bullying).
- ✓ Mental health issues (anxiety, depression, stress, anger, withdrawal) to guide towards appropriate supports.
- ✓ Family or personal problems affecting the player
- ✓ Injury welfare or overtraining concerns
- ✓ When a player discloses a serious issue or has a serious complaint.

Under 7/ 8 /9 /10 /11 are appointed by the Kolts and are Instructing Referees. They like the players are learning the game - they will make mistakes.



Where players are purposely and blatantly playing offside whether directed to or not, the referee will have the authority to award a free kick against the team whose player is purposely and blatantly playing offside, at the sole discretion of the referee.



2026 Laws and By Laws Updates & Focal Points



In 2026 for all mini football there will be a "Respect Card" that may be issued by Instructing Referees for all cases of dissent, offensive or abusive language, or violent conduct by players towards other players or to the referee

Should a player be shown a respect card, the coach or manager must immediately remove the player from the field of play for a cooling off period of 2 minutes (the time shall be managed by the players coach / manager).

The player can be substituted.

All Respect Cards are to be reported to VP Junior Football.





2026 Referees

Laws of the Game (and By-Laws)

8-Second Rule Key Details

The Limit: Goalkeepers have a maximum of 8 seconds to release the ball after gaining control with their hands/arms.

The Penalty: If the ball is held for longer, the opposing team is now awarded a corner kick (not an indirect free kick).

The Countdown: The referee will use a visible 5-second countdown signal (raised hand) when 3 seconds have passed, warning the keeper to release the ball.

Start Time: The timer begins at the discretion of the referee, when the goalkeeper has full control of the ball and is not being obstructed by an opponent.



2026 Laws and By Laws Updates & Focal Points



The Law 4 “no jewellery” will be strictly enforced again this season. This applies to all players, in all age groups, taking part in any match.



This is for ALL jewellery items including all necklaces, rings (including wedding rings), bracelets, earrings, piercings (that are visible), leather bands, rubber bands etc. Whether they have a religious significance or not – they are not part of the players equipment and as such CANNOT be worn



Where a referee sees any items that is not allowed, players will be asked to leave the field of play and remove them.



No taping of any item is allowed. Players that return to the field of play without removing the item will be issued a yellow card and asked to remove them again.



If players decide that they don't want to or cannot remove items, they will not be allowed to take any further part in the match.



2026 Referees

Laws of the Game (and By-Laws)

The Temporary dismissal – ALL matches U12 upwards there is now a sin bin in place for any dissent towards a match official.

for **all age groups in U12 – U16** the sin bin is for 5 minutes.

In U18 and above, it is a 10 minute sin bin.



The time is at the discretion of the match official not the coach. Players will be allowed to re-enter the field of play when advised by the referee, during a stoppage in play.



Please remember Referees are human and will make mistakes, but many situations are subjective and in the spirit of the game please try to respect their decisions.

Discipline & Code of Conduct

- The enforcement of discipline within the Club shall be vested in the Protest & Dispute Sub-Committee (P&D), which holds primary authority for determining and managing all disciplinary matters arising within the Club.
- The P&D shall be constituted by a Vice-President and any two (2) members of the Club's Committee, duly empowered to deliberate and reach determinations in accordance with the Club's Constitution.
- Disciplinary proceedings may be initiated against any Individual Member, or any Group of Members (Team), whose conduct is deemed to fall within the behaviours or breaches set out under Section 11 of the Club Constitution.



Discipline & Code of Conduct

- Disciplinary action may include, but is not limited by:
 - A verbal warning
 - A written warning
 - Suspension from one or more competition fixtures
 - Suspension from all Club-sanctioned football activities for a defined period, including training sessions and competitive matches
 - Revocation of Club membership

Discipline & Code of Conduct



- Under the Club's Code of Conduct, Coaches are authorised to impose a suspension of one (1) match upon any player within their team, without the need to refer the matter to the Protest & Dispute Sub-Committee (P&D).
- Coaches must, however, notify the relevant Vice-President in writing, providing the specific grounds for the suspension, to ensure accurate and complete Club records.

Discipline & Code of Conduct



- As a Team Official, you are required to lead by example and must refrain from any conduct that constitutes abuse, intimidation, or the incitement of violence towards any referee, match official, or player.
- Should you observe a player within your team engaging in outbursts, inappropriate conduct, or excessive behaviour, you are expected to substitute the player and provide appropriate counsel.



Discipline & Code of Conduct

- At Kellyville Kolts, the Club enforces a strict Zero-Tolerance policy regarding any form of abuse, intimidation, or threatening conduct.
- The Club will take appropriate disciplinary action against any individual who acts in contravention of this Disciplinary Policy.







DRIBL (electronic matchsheets)



Search DRIBL in your app store and install or click on the link on Stack Team App in our Kolts group...

- Step 1: Login and select Match Sheets
- Step 2: Before the game, tick players as P for playing, enter / update players shirt numbers, enter official's name and save (once entered in R1, shirt numbers will stay saved going forward)
- Step 3: Check and approve oppositions Match Sheet
- Step 4: After the game, enter the score and save

Top Tip: Avoid fines and disputes by checking the score with both the referee and opposition team manager at the completion of the game before submitting.

Team Sheet Fines

Team Sheet Related Fines:

1. First Offence: Written Warning
 2. Second Offence: \$10 fine
 3. Third Offence: 1 point deduction from team (and \$50)
 4. Fourth Offence: 3 point deduction from team (and \$50)
 5. Fifth Offence: Potential removal from competition
- Examples of Team Sheet Related Offences
 - No, late or incorrect result submitted (\$10 then \$50 thereafter)
 - More than the allowed players on team sheet
 - Non-numbered shirt
 - Missing upgraded players team on team sheet
 - Non completion of team sheet (prior and post- match)


