
Annual CO₂ emissions



Annual CO₂ Emissions - Regions of the World

Historic annual CO₂ emissions due to fossil fuels and industry for countries within the regions of Asia, North and South America, Europe, and the Middle East from 1750 to 2022.

Prior to the Industrial Revolution (1760-1840), worldwide CO₂ emissions were very low and growth in emissions remained slow until the mid-20th century, after which they began to grow in each region and rose sharply in the mid 20th century. Since then, Europe and North America have shown decreases.

2022 emissions for Asia were 21.44 billion tonnes, North America were 6.2 billion tonnes, Europe were 5.31 billion tonnes, the Middle Ease were 2.64, and South America were 1.09 billion tonnes.
