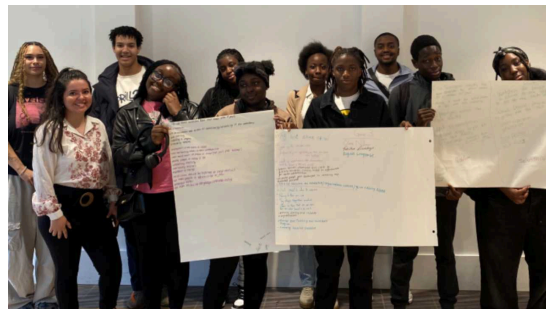
Environmental Ambassadors

Summer Scheme Success



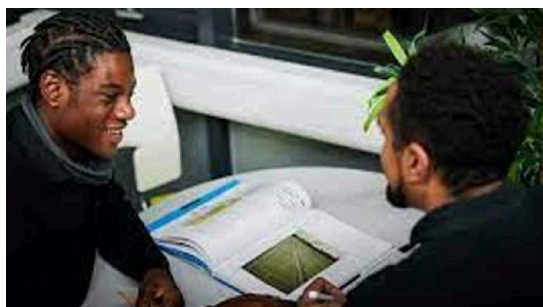

Safe In The City



The Voyage Safe in the City programme was conducted after being commissioned by the Haringey based school Grieg city academy. The programme targeted 20 at-risk young people.

The sessions focused on academic attainment, social skills development, empowerment, and self-belief. The group improved their ability to focus and learn from week to week, key learning outcomes included emotional literacy, effective communication, and positive attitudes toward learning. In the coming months, Voyage will be delivering similar courses across London.
