What We Achieved Together:

- **Convened 600+ creative professionals** across our events, fostering connections and collaboration that fuel career and industry development
- **Delivered signature programming**, including our 10th annual Creativity Speaks series, our 7th annual Design Week Sacramento, and a two-day creative conference
- **Mobilized our community with 2,000+ volunteer hours** contributed through our new skilled volunteer platform and event support
- **Expanded pathways for creatives** preparing to enter the workforce through continued partnership with Sacramento State on internships and faculty-led research
- **Launched fiscal sponsorship** with Art Tonic to build a regional Artist Network, extending our impact beyond our own programs
