Additional Parking

- Off road parking for approximately 50 cars created
- Promote the availability of the parking to students over the next few weeks
- Enhancements to the parking area being considered (line markings, litter bins, lighting)
- New gate to be installed behind Hartoft shops to encourage students to use the parking area (2minutes 45 seconds walk – yes, we timed it!!)
- Ongoing monitoring of usage



Traffic Enforcement

The patrol data for November visits are as follows:
