

# Wyke Transport 2026/27

The College will again be maintaining the number of services currently being offered from September 2026. Details of fares, routes and pick-up points for buses and minibuses are available on the website at <https://www.wyke.ac.uk/applicant-information/travelling-to-wyke> please note: transport timings/routes maybe subject to change, in the event of significant roadworks or the needs of the college.

It should be noted that if your journey into college is within the 95p zone, East Yorkshire Buses only (EYB), you will be able to pay by cash, card, google/apple pay on the bus itself.

For those travelling further, from zones 1 and 2, on **either** a college minibus or EYB bus we recommend that you buy an EYB e-ticket no later than Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2026 ready for the start of term.

To purchase an e-ticket you will need to download the [East Yorkshire Buses app](#). Tickets can be purchased from the beginning of enrolment week on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2026. If you do not have a suitable device to download the app, please contact the college on 01482 346347 or email [transport@wyke.ac.uk](mailto:transport@wyke.ac.uk) and another suitable means will be provided.

An e-ticket can be purchased in six equal payments and must be acquired before the commencement of the next period.

Please Note: All **Wyke Start** transport operated on 30 June/1 July 2026 will be free of charge.

**Ad-hoc travel on buses and minibuses** - Travel on EYB outside of the 95p zone and all minibuses maybe permitted on an ad-hoc basis (space permitting) without a pass but the cost will be double that of a normal journey.

On one of our minibus services you will need to buy a single journey ticket from the college library, which again will be double pass price, before you travel. If you plan to also make a return journey on a minibus, make sure you buy two tickets.

**Passes are transferable between EYB and minibuses** - College e-tickets can be used on any of the EYB services that are operated for the College and College minibuses. However, if you usually come into College on an EYB service, you will need to check there is capacity on the chosen minibus you would like to use. Please contact the Transport Supervisor in Oak 18.

**Payment reminders** - EYB e-tickets will count down until the date you are due to make the next payment, whereby a reminder will be sent.

**Financial help with travel costs** - Support is available to help via the 16-19 Bursary Fund. Completed applications must be submitted with the correct supporting evidence **no later than 31 July 2026** in order to be assessed before enrolment.

Confirmation of the assessment will be made at enrolment and successful applicants will then be able to obtain their travel pass at the start of term without payment. We can only guarantee to have travel passes available for the start of term if the application is received before the submission date, with all requested supporting evidence. Applications made after the submission date will be assessed within 10 working days. Once the application has been assessed students will be notified of the outcome. Successful applicants will then be able to obtain their travel pass without payment. If the pass has already been purchased, the cost will be reimbursed.
