

Wanting to Withdraw

If you are holding a firm unconditional place, you no longer wish to take, you can use the 'Decline my place' button in your application to apply using Clearing.

- Speak with your tutor or a member of staff.
- If you still wish to decline the offer, you can use the 'Decline my place' button in your application.
- If you use the button and complete the steps, your place will be declined and your contract with the university or college will be cancelled. This means you will lose your place so you should only use this button if you are sure, you no longer want to accept it.

Conditional Offer Holders Grades Met

You are holding a conditional firm or insurance place which has been marked as confirmed on UCAS – **Congratulations**. Your place is now secure. Make sure you check your emails for correspondence from the University.

If you want to change course but at the same university, contact them directly to see if this is possible.

If you want to change university at this stage, please speak with a member of staff.

Exceeded Predicted Grades

Your summer grades are higher than those that were originally predicted on your UCAS application.

You can contact universities with higher entry requirements than your original predictions, and see if they have space on the course, you are interested in. If they do have space and tell you that they will make you an offer, you can then apply through Clearing. Do NOT use Clearing until you are sure you want to and have confirmation of an offer from the alternative university.

Entering Clearing means you lose your current offers.

If you decline your place, you can use **Clearing Plus** which will automatically show you potential offers.

Missed Grades Place Unsuccessful

Your grades were not high enough for your place to be confirmed, and your choices have been marked as unsuccessful on UCAS.

You can:

- **Appeal Grades with Wyke** – The grounds for appeals are limited, speak with a member of staff.
- **Appeal to the University** - You may be considered for an alternative course (foundation year for example) at your preferred university. Contact them to see if this is possible.
- **Retake Exams** – You can re-take exams in the next academic year and reapply through UCAS.
- **Clearing** – If you still want to go to university, then you can use the Clearing process to find an alternative university place.

Missed Grades Place Confirmed or Awaiting Decision

You have not gained the entry requirements, but you have not been released into **Clearing**.

Awaiting Decision – The university may still be considering your place. Contact them directly for further information.

Alternative Offer – Your university may make an offer for a different course.

Place Confirmed – You might still be offered a place

Unconditional Offer

You are holding an unconditional place at your firm choice, and this has been marked as firm on UCAS – **Congratulations**. If your firm choice (or your insurance) is marked as unconditional on UCAS, your place is secure. Make sure you check your emails for correspondence from the university.

If you want to change university at this stage, please speak with a member of staff.

You can self-release into Clearing, you can "decline your place" but this cannot be undone.
