Food Support Resources

Do you or someone you know need help with securing food for yourself or your family? Lewis County has many resources available to help those in need.

- Many communities have local food pantries. Some have income requirements and others do not. But all can usually supply a family with emergency food regardless of income. Contact your local pantry to learn more.
- The Food \$en\$e program is open to anyone and helps lower the cost of some food staple items and has multiple pick up locations.
- A few churches offer local meals open to all in the community.
- The Department of Services can help you apply for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). Currently funding may or may not be available but they can help you apply for when it is available.

Snowmobile Safety Course

November 29, 2025 - 8:30am - 4:30pm Turin Library - Turin NY

The course hours are from 8:30am to 4:30pm with lunch being provided by the club. MUST REGISTER

Children from age 10 - 13 must take this course to be allowed to operate a snowmobile on lands upon which snowmobiling is allowed while accompanied by (within 500 feet of) a person who is at least 18 years of age.

Children from age 14 - 17 must take this course to be allowed to operate a snowmobile on lands upon which snowmobiling is allowed without being accompanied by a person who is at least 18 years of age.

A student must have reached his or her 10th birthday on or before the day the course ends in order to be eligible to receive a snowmobile safety certificate. Parents-legal guardians MUST stay the first 15 minutes so all paper work can be filled out. Students need a pen and a highlighter. Student that will need help reading, comprehending a 50 question fill in the blanks, true-false, multiple choice let the instructor know prior to the class.
