




- The fall of the Wall for Western Europe

Type of War	Main Characteristics	Typical actors	Tools and Methods used
Hybrid	Combination of conventional, irregular, and cyber/informational tactics	States, militias, hackers, armed groups	Disinformation, guerrilla tactics, cyberattacks, covert support
Conventional	Open warfare between states, regular armies, identifiable frontlines	States, regular armed forces	Infantry, tanks, aircraft, artillery
Nuclear	Use or threat of use of nuclear weapons, massive strategic impact	Nuclear-armed states	Ballistic missiles, nuclear warheads



Estimated number of nuclear warheads in Europe



“If a Member State is the victim of armed aggression on its territory, the other Member States shall have towards it an obligation of aid and assistance by all the means in their power”




French opinion, Elab pol, May 2, 2024

- 74 % support pooling programs and technologies
- 80 % support creation of an anti-missile shield
- 69 % are in favor of establishing a rapid reaction force
- 51 % (versus 49 %) support pooling the nuclear deterreny


Deterring the aggressor (conventional and nuclear)
