075 GOTHARD

Side 1 START >>>

(low) Rocco?

076 ROCH

(weak)

Gothard, please enter.

DOG BARKS TWICE.

077 GOTHARD

Amico has been at the foot of your bed for months now.

078 ROCH

He's a faithful companion.

079 GOTHARD

Yes. Very loyal. And I think he likes his new name. Don't you, Amico?

DOG BARKS ONCE.

080 ROCH

It's very kind, Gothard, but you didn't have to change his name for me.

081 GOTHARD

It was necessary. I believe Amico was sent by God to find you in the wilderness. Otherwise, you would have died alone in that hut.

082 ROCH

And when he licked my wounds, he miraculously healed me of the pestilence.

083 GOTHARD

A miracle, indeed. The servants assigned to your care say you're making slow, but steady progress.

084 ROCH

Your staff has been most helpful.

085 GOTHARD

They did bring something to my attention about you. They were discussing the unusual bright red birthmark on your chest - in the shape of the cross of our Lord.

086 ROCH

Yes. My Grandmère believes it was a sign from God, after my parents prayed to have a child.

087 GOTHARD

It's the symbol of the Crusaders. Which leads me to believe that you have more to do on this earth. That God saved you, Rocco, for a reason.

088 ROCH

I've been searching my whole life for God's purpose for me. I was given the gift of healing, but I wasn't able to heal my parents or myself.

089 GOTHARD

Maybe your purpose isn't to be a pilgrim but return to your home. You told me of your uncle back in France.

090 ROCH

Yes, Uncle Claude. He's the one who made me see that my selfish actions claimed the lives of my parents.

091 GOTHARD

And you gave all of your power to him?

092 ROCH

He offered to take it.

093 GOTHARD

Exactly. I don't know your uncle, but what if that was his plan all along. To take the governorship from you.

094 ROCH

My Grandmère did warn me about my uncle. But I don't believe he would be that evil.

095 GOTHARD

Power makes people do unscrupulous things. Not everyone is as loyal as a doq.

096 ROCH

If they were, the world would be a much better place. Isn't that right, Amico?

THE DOG BARKS.

097 GOTHARD

Well, you don't have to make any decisions today. You may stay and convalesce at my estate as long as <<< END you need.

098 ROCH

Grazie, Gothard. But I'm sure my Grandmère's wondering what has become of me.
