073 FANCHON

wanted me to come over and keep an

074 JEANNE  
I'm fine. In fact, I'd like to get  
up...

076 JEANNE  
But I want to get dressed. I have

JEANNE CONTINUES THROWING OFF HER BLANKETS

077 FANCHON

Please, Jeanne, get back in bed.  
Mirielle said -

MIRIELLE CAN BE HEARD COMING UP THE STAIRS

078 FANCHON (CONT'D)

Oh, here she is now...

MIRIELLE ENTERS

079 MIRIELLE

Jeanne - what are you doing getting

080 JEANNE

MIRIELLE GOES TO HER, HELPS HER LIE DOWN
