053 HENRY

I tried to warn you, but now -

054 LUDWIG

(Halting his horse)
Is this about Elizabeth?

055 HENRY

She steals the goods of our castle
to give them to the poor.

056 LUDWIG

So long as she does not sell the
castle, I am happy with her!

057 HENRY

Is this a joke to you? She is
irresponsible. And you, brother,
are unfit to be Landgrave.

058 LUDWIG

Watch yourself, Henry.

059 HENRY

Your love for Elizabeth is clouding
your judgment.

060 LUDWIG

My love for Elizabeth has given our
kingdom an heir. And that heir is
not you, Henry.

061 HENRY

Droves of penniless beggars crowd
our castle gates daily.

062 LUDWIG

This has been a tough winter.
Elizabeth models what all our noble
women should be doing.

063 HENRY

Do you not see? Giving away such
riches sets a dangerous precedent.
The peasants will grow lazy and
entitled, and we will lose our
power over them.

064 LUDWIG

The people trust me and they trust
Elizabeth.

065 HENRY

When their bellies are full, the
poor get ideas. They will no longer
be grateful; they will be clamoring
for more. It could lead to
violence, Ludwig.

066 LUDWIG
Generosity breeds generosity, not
contempt!

067 HENRY
You and Elizabeth could end up
without a castle to live in.

068 LUDWIG
(Smiling)
Is that a threat, Henry?

069 HENRY

You inherited your title, Ludwig.
