# 023 MERNEPTAH

(spiteful)

Well? Do you not have his ear?!

## 024 MOSES

He is more interested in your heart, Pharaoh. He desires that you repent, and hear his people's groans. Release them once and for all from their sufferings.

## 025 MERNEPTAH

What do you want of me, nephew? Have you come back as from the dead only to torment me?! Our lands were unbothered before you returned! Even your kinsfolk lived in peace!

# 026 MOSES

They lived in slavery, even if they had grown accustomed to it. But no longer. Are you deaf to the cries? Has your heart grown so hardened as to drown out your fellow man?

# 027 MERNEPTAH

(in disgust)

Fellow man? I am a son of Egypt!

## 028 MOSES

Yes, Merneptah, son and Pharaoh. But still you are a man! A man who enslaves other men - enslaves the chosen people of the Most High! And you think he will not punish you in return?

# MOSES (CONT'D)

He will protect his children, the heirs of his promise!

#### 029 MERNEPTAH

Do you wish me to beg, is that it? I beg of you, Moses! Yes, the pharaoh himself begs! Have your god send these monstrous locusts away. Remove this death from our land! lift this burden from my people.

#### 030 MOSES

"Burden"? Now you know something of the shackles you have put on mine.

036 AARON

037 MOSES
