Do not speak imprudently, Paser. If the Hebrews outnumber us, they might revolt. Our hand must be heavy against them.

028 PASER

What are your orders, my Lord?

029 RAMSES

The Hebrews are a problem, but they are simple creatures. If they fear us in their hearts, they will not rise up against us. If we stop them from multiplying so quickly, they will be unable to rise up against us.

BITHIAH ENTERS.

030 BITHIAH

Father!

031 RAMSES

Bithiah! Daughter, please, do not interrupt-

032 BITHIAH

Father, how could you! How could you keep this news from me?!

033 RAMSES

What news, child?

034 BITHIAH

My husband died in Kadesh?!

035 RAMSES

It was a great and mighty battle. Many men died. Even some of your brothers died, Bithiah. But they will be avenged, and we will soon have peace.

036 BITHIAH

Peace?! Peace won't bring my husband back! Father, you do not know what it is like to be childless! Your thirteenth son was born this very month!

037 RAMSES

Do not speak to me like this, Bithiah. I rule as a god over Egypt. I would do anything for you, and I can find a way to ensure you will not remain childless.

038 BITHIAH

Father! I-

039 RAMSES

Enough. Leave me now, my daughter. I have much larger problems to deal with at the moment. Paser!

BITHIAH EXITS.

040 PASER

Yes, Pharaoh?

041 RAMSES

Make ready my vessel. Let us float down the Nile and see the Hebrews <<< END for ourselves.

EXT. THE NILE RIVER - DAY
