084 GREGORY

Bishop, may I have a word?

085 WYNFRITH

Of course, Gregory.

086 GREGORY

Perhaps, Bishop, it is time to wipe the dust from our feet in Hesse.

087 WYNFRITH

Not you, too, Gregory. You want us to leave?

088 GREGORY

Think of what our Lord says in the Gospel. If men reject the Gospel, you wipe the dust from your feet and move on. They've heard you. Then they beat you. Time to wipe the dust.

089 WYNFRITH

These men have not rejected the Gospel here, Greogry. Think of Theobald. Think of the men here we have befriended, who've helped us to build. Think of all the sick we've helped in our infirmary.

090 **GREGORY**

We would be better stewards of what God has given us if we turn our time and attention to the places the people do want Christ. Saxony. Thuringia. But Bishop, Hesse is stony ground.

091 **WYNFRITH**

God's love will soak in. Hesse will bear a great harvest. We must be patient.

092 **GREGORY**

Bishop, we are throwing pearls to swine!

093 **WYNFRITH**

No, Gregory. The Hessians do not reject Christ, not yet. The fear of Donar blinds them. If we can just show them, bit by bit, day by day, a longsuffering love -

094 **GREGORY**

And how long will you let this suffering go on?

095 **WYNFRITH**

If it is the fear of martyrdom that causes you concern--

096 **GREGORY**

(interrupting)

Wynfrith, it is not martyrdom to die because of your stubborn refusal to see reality!

(a beat, more gently)

Wynfrith. Bishop Boniface. I am sorry. I didn't mean that.

097 **WYNFRITH**

It...It is forgiven. I...You're right. It is not easy to know what to do. If you think we should leave Hesse, please, speak with the brothers. I would have their counsel in this matter as well.

098 **GREGORY**

I am sorry, Bishop. I didn't mean to--

099 WYNFRITH
(interrupting)
Ask the brothers what they think,
Gregory. Now.

100 GREGORY
Yes, excellency. **<<< END**

101 WYNFRITH
(softly)
May God's will be revealed through
my brothers. Come, Holy Spirit.
