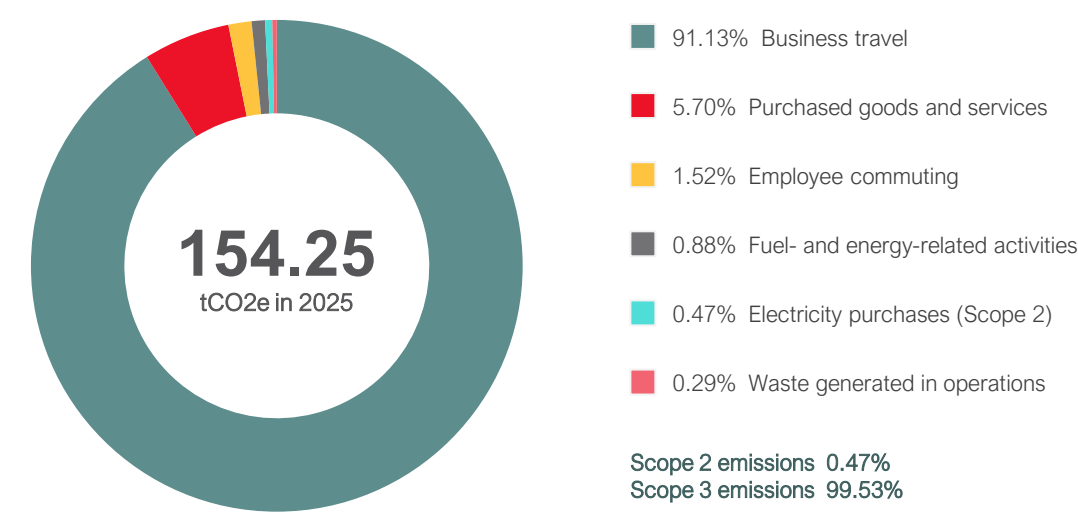
Which emissions are included

Our greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions are calculated in line with the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard, covering material emission sources across Scopes 1, 2 and 3. The data allows us to monitor our carbon footprint and make decisions to reduce its impact.

Minimising our footprint

Purchased goods and services

We have a strong focus on purchasing second-hand equipment, from office furniture to computer screens, using companies specialised in repurposing. Employees are given incentives to buy second-hand phones.

Business travel

We minimise business travel by replacing some trips with video calls, combining trips for different purposes and taking the train where possible. We are developing screening criteria to reduce travel further.

Investing in mitigation contributions

We retire high-quality carbon credits equivalent to 100% of our emissions, using projects rated “A” or “A+” by Calyx Global, as a voluntary contribution to global mitigation.
