Pray for open doors for evangelism. Pray for those who have been working on translating portions of Scripture. Pray for seeds of the Gospel to be planted among the Bafinda and that their eyes would be opened to the Good News.</p> | |

Most Karachay have returned to their homeland and have preserved much of their heritage and cultural traditions. There are fewer than 50 known followers of Jesus. Pray that the believers' demonstration of God's love and redemptive grace would cause people to seek hope in Christ.</p> | |
| <p>9 This week, Media Manager Jonas Santos is meeting with Korean ministry partners for project updates, and discussions over the media strategies for the Peninsula. Pray for a blessed time for everyone participating.</p> | <p>10 Pray for Nitha's trip to a remote station in Feb to mentor a manager and provide training for some new volunteers. Translated as "People of the Forest," the Tanala are skilled woodsmen, food gatherers, and hunters. Their ethnic religion is deeply rooted within their identity. Pray for the small number of believers and pray that many more will come to faith in Christ.</p> | |
