They are a proud, respected people who once held major political influence. Although strongly Islamic, they mix folk religion into their practice. It is unsafe for the tiny Kumyk church to exist publicly. Ask God to open the hearts of Kumyk elders and leaders to hear and receive the Gospel.</p>

The Balai are practicing Hindus with a particular focus on the mother warrior goddess Durga. Pray that the Balai would hear the message of Jesus and how He has come to set the captives free. Pray that the Balai would receive Jesus as their Lord and Savior.</p>

They have several centuries of preserved literature, which includes Taoist rituals. Pray for the lu Mien to see Jesus as Lord. Pray for those who hear the Gospel to receive it and to walk in the truth. Pray for the small number of lu Mien believers to be bold in sharing Jesus.</p>	
<p>23 A radio station that shut down several years ago is being restored, on a remote island in eastern-central Indonesia. Pray with Janice for the local church that has adopted this project, and ask God's help as they seek announcers and finance.</p>	<p>24 RB Australia asks for prayer for good health and safety for our partners in Myanmar as they go about their ministries. Muslims wear charms that include pictures of a holy man and Koranic verses, Catholic charms include a picture of Christ or a church leader, and animists wear charms that include parts of an animal or ancestor that died long ago. Pray that the Sereer find true freedom in Christ.</p>
