
Engage with Mount Baker Station Redevelopment Project

Next month, we'll be joining neighbors, partners, and local leaders for an inspiring community update on the **Mt. Baker Station Redevelopment Project**—a transformative, community-led effort shaping the future of South Seattle.

Led by **El Centro de la Raza** and **Mercy Housing Northwest**, the redevelopment will bring **438 new units of affordable housing**, a **UW-owned Early Learning Center**, and vibrant public spaces designed to celebrate culture and connection. The project continues to stand as a testament to what's possible when design and development are rooted in equity, collaboration, and local voices.


