#### All Ranks LGBT+ Conference

This year marks twenty-five years since the lifting of the ban on LGBT+ Service Personnel serving in His Majesty's Armed Forces.

Anniversaries offer unique opportunities for us to reflect, discuss and learn. LGBT+ veterans experienced entrenched institutional prejudice in undertaking the long and often painful journey that helped us to this point, and we must not lose sight of their unique stories and experiences. It is crucial to the moral fabric and operational effectiveness of the Army that our organisation remains an inclusive organisation in which all service personnel feel respected, valued and able to fully represent themselves both inside and out of uniform.

As part of our year of reflection, the Army's LGBT+ Network is planning to hold an all ranks Conference that will examine our past, discuss the current situation and help frame our thinking about the future. There will also be a dinner for members of the Army LBGT+ community allowing both active serving personnel, allies and importantly veterans to gather together. The events will take place in London.

To enable planning, we are seeking initial/non-committal Expressions of Interest. Costs for the dinner are being investigated and will be rank-ranged.
