Project Overview

Neighbouring the iconic Selfridges store on Oxford Street, London, the fully refurbished Parcels Building is now home to FORA's new co-working space in the heart of the city.

The project required a premium internal glazed partitioning system that could deliver both high acoustic performance and a striking visual finish, aligned with FORA's design aspirations.

Our Solution

SioSystems designed and delivered a solution using our Silence 25 and Silence 59 systems, paired with Syncra and Fulcra framed doors. To enhance both function and aesthetic, we incorporated timber handles and natural reeded glass for privacy and texture.

A highlight of the project was the creation of a completely unique curved screen with reeded glass on the second floor, alongside a vertical 75mm light feature next to the office doors.

Outcome & Impact

The result is a set of acoustically sound and visually refined meeting rooms, tailored to the specific needs of the space.

The bespoke system not only met but exceeded the high design aspirations of the client, reinforcing FORA's reputation for delivering inspiring and high-quality co-working environments in London.
