



# Mass Save Commercial Heat Pump Offer Update

The Commercial Heating and Cooling heat pump rebate and incentive amounts, and commitment letter expiration period are changing. Increased interest in commercial heat pumps is driving these changes, which have been carefully considered in order to appropriately disperse funding through the duration of the Massachusetts 2025-2027 Energy Efficiency and Decarbonization Plan.

- New incentive amounts for commercial heat pumps listed below will take effect **January 1, 2026**.
- Rebate Commitment Letters are valid for a 6-month period, effective **September 15, 2025**.

Air Source Variable Refrigerant Flow (VRF)	\$3,500 per ton	\$2,800 per ton	
Ground Source Heat Pumps (GSHPs)	\$4,500 per ton	\$3,600 per ton	

**Equipment installed on or before December 31, 2025, will qualify for the current rebate amounts.** Rebate form and supporting documentation must be received by February 28, 2026. **This change does not affect residential heat pump rebates and incentives.**
