Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 32-7-2, Ware County Planning & Codes Department will send certified letters notifying all property owners located on the road that a hearing will be had to determine whether a substantial public purpose is served that would necessitate the road remaining open.

The Ware County Planning Director shall coordinate the review of the request with the GIS Coordinator, County Attorney, Public Works (traffic and drainage), Water and Sewer Authority, County Police, County Fire, & Utility Providers (power, telephone, cable, & gas) and other departments as necessary. All comments made by reviewers shall be written and returned to the Ware County Planning Director within (30) days of the application filing date.

The Ware County Planning Director shall prepare a staff report based upon the written findings and forward it to the Ware County Commission.

The Planning Director or his designee shall advertise a public hearing, giving the nature of the request, the place, date, and time of the hearing in the local newspaper at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing. The beginning and ending of the road easement closing/abandoning shall be posted with the same information by the Planning Department.

It is understood by the undersigned that an easement by Ware County may be retained for drainage, utilities or other purposes.
