I qualified as a Speech and Language Therapist (BSc Hons) in 2000; however, I quickly found my passion for case management and have worked as a Case Manager for 23 years. My caseloads have included children and young people with brain injury, spinal injury, cerebral palsy and other physical, sensory and complex neurological difficulties. I have also worked with adults with acquired brain injury, cerebral palsy and spinal injury and have managed large teams of Support Workers providing 24-hour support to clients in their own homes.

I have developed an expertise in working with children and families, an intrinsic part of which is supporting the journey through the education system. I have experience of enabling families to achieve appropriate levels of support to best meet the needs of their child. I work in partnership with other rehabilitation professionals including those from health, education and social care as part of an interdisciplinary team approach from discharge planning through to rehabilitation in the home setting and I have coordinated intensive rehabilitation programmes for children and adults with complex needs. I have also managed integrated therapy and support packages spanning the home and education environments. I have in depth medico legal knowledge and experience and the majority of my cases are clients who are going through the litigation process.
