Lisa started her career as an oncology nurse, providing care for people with spinal injuries that had developed because of cancer, often causing irreversible paralysis, resulting in the need for bladder/bowel management, and the risks associated with venous thromboembolism and tissue viability. She went on to nurse patients with acquired and traumatic brain injuries caused by accidents, strokes, tumours, infection and dementia. A large part of her work was to plan and initiate effective discharge from hospital by ongoing liaison and referral to community teams, such as GP, specialist nurse therapists and social workers.

Lisa retains her nursing registration providing care and expertise to adults with a wide range of complex conditions and can provide ongoing nursing and care expertise. Lisa offers ongoing guidance and support to carers once recruited and also offers supervision to other case managers alongside managing her own caseload.
