Failure to timely file a notice of protest and subsequent formal written protest shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.

Protests must reference the solicitation number and clearly state the grounds upon which the protest is based. All protest filings may be submitted electronically to cgarcia@elcosceola.org and must be received within the applicable statutory deadlines.
